5 Members, independent of trustees, who;

- Sign/amend articles
- Appoint/remove trustees
- Receive annual accounts

TRUSTEES

7 or 9 Trustees (including the Trust Leader) who;

1. Ensure clarity of vision, core beliefs and strategic direction of Embark Federation
2. Hold executive leaders to account for the educational performance of Embark Federation; and its pupils, and the performance enhancement of staff
3. Oversee the financial performance of Embark Federation, making sure its money is well spent
4. Ensure integrity of the Scheme of Delegation

TRUST Committees

1. **School Performance Committee** – to ensure a constant review of standards, progress and disseminating best practice
2. **Finance, Audit and Risk Committee**- to assist the decision making of the Board of Trustees by enabling more detailed consideration to ensure sound management for the Trust finances and resources
3. **Safeguarding Committee** – to ensure a constant review of safeguarding across all schools.
4. **People and Pay Committee** – to ensure the Trust meets its statutory requirements in respect of pay and performance.
5. **Vision Sprint Committee** – development / growth interrogation

Local Governing Teams Forum (termly)

Local Governing Teams at each school made up of 9 or 11 governors, who;

- Shape vision and strategy for the school within the MAT core beliefs
- Hold school leaders to account for educational performance and the performance enhancement of staff
- Ensure local school finances are well spent
- Monitor the 'Helping Hands' School Improvement Cycle
- Work to the Scheme of Delegation
- Engage with stakeholders within the local community
